FROM THE DESK OF FR ERIC ANDERSEN

This past week we celebrated a glorious Rogation week leading up to Ascension Thursday. The paschal candle was extinguished on Ascension Thursday after the gospel and removed from the sanctuary until next Easter. Now, we prepare in prayer for Pentecost. We have one week of Ascensiontide followed by the Octave of Pentecost including three Ember Days. The Octave of Pentecost will conclude with Holy Trinity Sunday. Traditionally, Holy Trinity Sunday has been the deadline for fulfilling one's Easter Duty: which is to make a sacramental Confession at least once a year during the Easter Season and receive Holy Communion in a state of grace, after doing so, at least once a year in the Easter Season.

Since we did not cease the hearing of Confessions at St. Stephen's during the recent virus outbreak, I am hoping that all have had a chance to fulfill the first part of the Easter Duty. I am also hoping that all parishioners will have had an opportunity to attend Mass and receive Holy Communion at least once since we reopened for Masses two weeks ago. I will continue to hear Confessions and you can catch me before Mass if needed.
