PLENARY INDULGENCE ON PENTECOST SUNDAY

A Plenary Indulgence may be gained by publicly saying or singing the *Veni Creator Spiritus* on Pentecost Sunday. The usual conditions are as follows:

- One must intend to gain the indulgence (for oneself or a soul in Purgatory);
- Go to Sacramental Confession 7-10 days before or after Pentecost;
- Be free of all attachment to sin, even venial sin (recite the act of contrition);
- Receive Holy Communion in a state of grace for each plenary indulgence;
- Pray for the Holy Father's intentions (Our Father and an Apostles Creed).

SUNDAY LUNCH VOLUNTEERS NEEDED

We needed a minimum of 3 consistent volunteers for each of the 4 - 5 Sundays per month who come in from 9:30-10:20 am (before the 10:30 am Mass) to help do simple tasks such as washing fruits, cutting vegetables, making coffee, setting out plastic cutlery, cutting bread, etc. This is not labor intensive nor complicated, but it is enough busy work that it cannot be done in time by 1-2 people. Ideally each volunteer is dedicated to one of the four Sundays per month, that way they really only have to come in once a month. The total number of lunch prep volunteers would thus need to be around 15 people, though more is always better. Clean up crew is also needed for the end of the lunch.
