NINE TUESDAYS OF ST. ANTHONY OF PADUA - WEEK FIVE

We began Easter Tuesday and will conclude Tuesday, June 17th. The Feast of St. Anthony falls this year on Ember Friday, June 13th. Many favors have been obtained by those who have made this Novena. Look up the playlist for the Nine Tuesdays of St. Anthony for archived weekly videos on the parish YouTube channel. Here are the rules:

- 1) Recite for nine consecutive Tuesdays the prayer or prayers you find most appropriate (provided in the church and on the website)
- 2) Endeavor to imitate his virtues.
- 3) Receive within the period of the Novena, if possible, the Sacrament of the Holy Eucharist.
- 4) Promise alms for St. Anthony's Bread for the poor, if you have the means.

THE LEGION OF MARY

The object of the Legion of Mary is the glory of God through the holiness of its members developed by prayer and active co-operation in Mary's and the Church's work. The unit of the Legion of Mary is called a praesidium, which holds a weekly meeting, where prayer is intermingled with reports and discussion. Persons who wish to join the Legion must apply for membership in a Praesidium. The Legion sees as its priority the spiritual and social welfare of each individual. The members participate in the life of the parish through visitation of families, the sick, both in their homes and in hospitals and through collaboration in every apostolic and missionary undertaking sponsored by the parish. Every legionary is required to carry out a weekly apostolic work in the spirit of faith and in union with Mary. The Gate of Heaven Praesidium meets each Thursday in Carmody Hall from 7-8:30 pm. Visitors are welcome.

ROGATION DAYS AND ASCENSION THURSDAY

The Rogations Days are a Triduum in preparation for Ascension Thursday. Historically, these are semi-penitential days during which there are processions of the Crucifix raised in the air. Our Lord is ascending into Heaven. We lift Him up in procession and follow after Him.
