### FROM THE DESK OF FR ERIC ANDERSEN

October is the month of the Rosary. Do you pray the Rosary daily? If not, now is the time to start. The Rosary is called Mary's Psalter because it traditionally contains 150 Hail Mary's to represent the 150 Psalms that are prayed weekly in the Divine Office. The Rosary is divided up by day into different mysteries that are meditated upon while one is fingering the beads and praying the Apostles Creed, Our Fathers, Hail Marys and Glory Be's. Sunday: Glorious Mysteries from Easter until Advent. Sunday: Joyful Mysteries from Advent until Lent. Sunday: Sorrowful Mysteries during Lent. Mondays and Thursdays: Joyful Mysteries. Tuesdays and Fridays: Sorrowful Mysteries. Wednesdays and Saturdays: Glorious Mysteries. Plenary Indulgence every day when prayed publicly or with another person.
