### **FACE COVERING REQUIREMENTS**

What are the Face Covering Requirements in Churches? Face coverings are legally required at indoor gatherings, including in churches, per statewide directive. All who are 5 years and up must wear face coverings in church in Phases 1 and 2 of reopening. Those are excepted who perform activity that makes wearing a face covering "not feasible," like the presider (throughout Mass) and the lectors/cantors (while reading/singing). Exceptions are also made for people with disabilities or diagnosed medical conditions that preclude them from wearing face coverings. In these few cases, special seating accommodations should be made so those unable to wear face coverings have seating in a cry room or choir loft away from the rest gathered. Children 2 and under should not wear face coverings. Wearing a face covering at church is not optional. Churchgoers cannot be allowed entrance without a face covering.

## FROM THE DESK OF FR ERIC ANDERSEN

There is a beautiful blessing of Herbs (garden produce: fruits and vegetables) on the Feast of the Assumption of the Blessed Virgin Mary. The blessing is given after the Asperges and before the High Mass begins; or before Low Mass begins. It recalls how Moses commanded “the children of Israel to carry their sheaves of new grain to the priests for a blessing, to pluck the finest fruits of the orchards and to make merry before Thee, the Lord their God...may we likewise, laden with sheaves of good works, deserve to be lifted up to heaven. The fruits are then sprinkled with holy water and incensed.

You may remember that during the Summer Ember Days, we set as a goal to bring the harvest of our spiritual fruits (sheaves of good works) to present to the Lord on August 15th. Well, we are now at that time with one week to go. Please bring a sampling of your garden produce if you have some - make sure it is without blemish - the most perfect of your produce - to be blessed. More importantly, bring a loving and contrite heart to celebrate this great Solemnity.
