FROM THE DESK OF FR ERIC ANDERSEN

This weekend we celebrate the Solemnity of Christ the King which was originally promulgated in 1925 for the Last Sunday in October. Christ reigns in His Kingdom which is the Mystical Body of Christ: In Heaven (the Church Triumphant); in Purgatory (the Church Suffering); on Earth (the Church Militant). This Feast day is a reminder of our unity with the holy living souls of those who have preceded us in the temporal death of the body (the Saints in heaven and the holy souls in Purgatory). As we prepare for the Solemnity of All Saints, let us be mindful to keep the vigil of that great holy day, a holy vigil. Beginning with sung First Vespers of All Saints next Saturday evening Oct 31st, we will have Adoration of the Blessed Sacrament until Midnight. What a beautiful way to usher in such a holy day. Let us sanctify that Eve of all the Holy Ones (the Saints). Children may dress in saint costumes but adults in costume will not be admitted. Beginning Sunday, November 1st through Nov 8th, there is a plenary indulgence offered for visiting a cemetery and praying for the dead under the usual conditions of sacramental Confession, Holy Communion and praying for the Holy Father.
