## FROM THE DESK OF FR ERIC ANDERSEN

This week we celebrate the **Octave of Pentecost**.

Wednesday, Friday and Saturday are **Ember Days of Pentecost** during which we consecrate the season of Summer by these three Fast Days. Wed and Sat are partial abstinence (1 meal with meat); Friday is full abstinence (no meat). All three days are fast days (1 full meal; 2 partial meals not equalling a full meal). These are not obligatory, but recommended.

Thank you to all who have prayed along on the Pentecost Novena, and those who have watched the daily videos. I will film three videos this week for the three Ember Days and a fourth video for Holy Trinity Sunday.

One of the gifts that the LORD has brought in this time of the CCP Virus, is that we have been able to add the singing of Lauds and Vespers to the daily schedule. Lauds is morning prayer and Vespers is evening prayer. A priest's daily prayer schedule includes these, but in most parishes, they are prayed quietly by the priest alone, or recited in a small group in the church or chapel. The singing of these liturgies in a more formal way is a great gift and is sure to cultivate vocations.
