FROM THE DESK OF FR ERIC ANDERSEN

This week is the 19th Week After Pentecost. Normally, a Sunday does not share another feast but takes precedence as the LORD's day. Last week, however, was a parish solemnity of the Anniversary of the Dedication of St. Stephen's Church. That celebration replaced the 18th Sunday After Pentecost. This week, the 19th Sunday After Pentecost takes precedence, but the Feast of the Maternity of the Blessed Virgin Mary is commemorated at Mass and in the Divine Office. This means that there are two sets of prayers which are prayed one after the other at Mass. The primary Collect is prayed and followed by the Commemoration Collect. This way, we can celebrate two things at once. The Sunday has priority, but the feast is also observed. The Collect, the Secret, and the Post Communion prayers at Mass will be doubled. At Lauds and Vespers, there will be a second Benedictus antiphon and a second Magnificat antiphon followed by a second collect prayer at both Hours of the Office. Having read this, you will be "in the know" about what is happening.

Also, we have sent the statue of St. Stephen to be repaired and repainted. Let us pray for his quick return and for the artist, Bill Mitchell, who will be repairing and repainting our St. Stephen statue.
