FROM THE DESK OF FR ERIC ANDERSEN

It is time to prepare for Ascension Thursday. This week, the church traditionally observes three Rogation Days on Monday, Tuesday, and Wednesday - preceding Ascension Thursday. These are penitential days which preferably include a procession during which long litanies are sung or prayed, and penitential Masses in violet vestments are celebrated. While there is a penitential spirit during these days, no fasting or abstinence is required. The sentiment is one of sadness and mourning because Our LORD has told us that He is going to depart. We do understand, of course, that He is always with us, and He has promised that He must depart so that He can send the Holy Spirit, the Paraclete; and He has promised that He will prepare a place for us, and that He will come back and take us with Him. Please join me for video novena during this Triduum before Ascension, and during the nine days (novena) between Ascension and Pentecost during which we will pray for the coming of the Holy Spirit.
