This week, we are preparing for a Novena to All the Holy Souls which will begin this coming Saturday, October 24th: the Feast of St. Raphael the Archangel. Since St. Raphael guided young Tobias on his way, so we trust him to guide us through this novena. Along the way, we will celebrate the Solemnity of Christ the King, which is a fairly new feast, having been promulgated in 1925. As the Kingdom has been established and Christ has claimed His throne, we will then focus on those who occupy His kingdom: the Church Militant on earth; the Church Suffering in Purgatory; and the Church Triumphant in Heaven. To that end, we will celebrate the Feast of All Saints on Sunday, November 1st and conclude with the Commemoration of All the Holy Souls the following day, Monday, November 2nd.
