NOVENA TO THE HOLY FACE OF JESUS FEB 21ST - MAR 1ST

The devotion of the Holy Face has, for its principle object, the rendering to the adorable Face of Jesus Christ, disfigured in the Passion, a special homage of respect and love; of repairing the blasphemies and the violation of Sunday which outrages it afresh, and lastly, the obtaining from God the conversion of blasphemers and of those who profane His holy day. The engravings of the Holy Face are the reproduction of the veil of Veronica at the Vatican. The Feast of the Holy Face falls on Shrove Tuesday (Fat Tuesday) which falls this year on March 1st. Copies will be available at the church and on the parish website. Daily video prayers and meditations will be on the parish YouTube channel.

FAST AND ABSTINENCE LAWS AND DISCIPLINES

The **current law** of the Church obliges those age 14 and over to **abstain from meat** on Ash Wednesday and all Fridays of Lent. Those age 18 through 59 are also obliged to **fast** on Ash Wednesday and Good Friday.

Fasting is defined as one full meal and two other meals which, when combined are less than a full meal.

The **former practice** and discipline in place in 1962 obliged those age 7 and over to **full abstinence** from meat on all Fridays of the year, Ash Wednesday, Holy Saturday, and the Vigil of Christmas (Christmas Eve).

Likewise, **formerly, partial abstinence** (meat permitted once a day at the principle meal): all the days of Lent, the Ember Days of Wednesday and Saturday, and the Vigils of Pentecost and the Assumption.

The **former law** for **fasting** applied to those age 21 through 59. Fasting was to be done on all days of Lent (except Sundays) from Ash Wednesday inclusive, Ember Days, and the Vigils of Christmas, Pentecost and the Assumption.
