This week we enter into the Time After Pentecost, aka Tempus Per Annum (Time through the Year). On this Holy Trinity Sunday, it is good to read over and pray through the Athanasian Creed, which will be prayed Sunday morning in the Office of Prime.

Also this week is the Feast of Corpus Christi on Thursday. It is a commemoration of Holy Thursday and the first Mass offered by Jesus Christ Himself. The emphasis on this Feast will that of the Sacred Body of the LORD in the Holy Eucharist. On July 1st, we will celebrate the Feast of the Precious Blood which completes the Feast of Corpus Christi by dedicating the entire month of July to the Precious Blood on the Cross and in the Holy Eucharist.
