FROM THE DESK OF FR ERIC ANDERSEN

I will be away this week with the Priestly Fraternity of St. Joseph - a group of mainly diocesan priests who meet in Montana each August for our plenary assembly and Eucharistic Conference which includes daily Solemn Latin Masses, conferences, recreation and a 40 Hours Devotion with 2 processions. When I return, it is a good opportunity to revise our temporary Mass schedule. Now that we are able to gather 50 people in the church, plus with the additional seating in the chapel, we should be able to get all of our registered parishioners in to Mass every weekend. Weekdays will be reduced to one Mass per day other than Wednesdays which will still have 2 Masses.
