**“First Wednesday, First Thursday, First Friday, First Saturday”**

We have observed First Friday and First Saturday at the parish since before I arrived here, by means of Mass and devotions to the Sacred Heart of Jesus and the Immaculate Heart of Mary. There is an additional devotion for First Thursdays to Jesus Christ, the Eternal High Priest. It seems fitting that we give the LORD the best we have to give, and so starting this Thursday, October 1st, we will begin this devotion by praying the Litany to Jesus Christ the Eternal High Priest after the Mass. I would also like to begin observing the First Wednesdays by means of praying the Litany to St. Joseph after Mass on those respective days.

Prior to last April, it was the custom on First Saturdays to pray the Rosary out loud after the Saturday morning Mass during Confessions. I would like to see that happen again if we can get volunteers to get that started.
